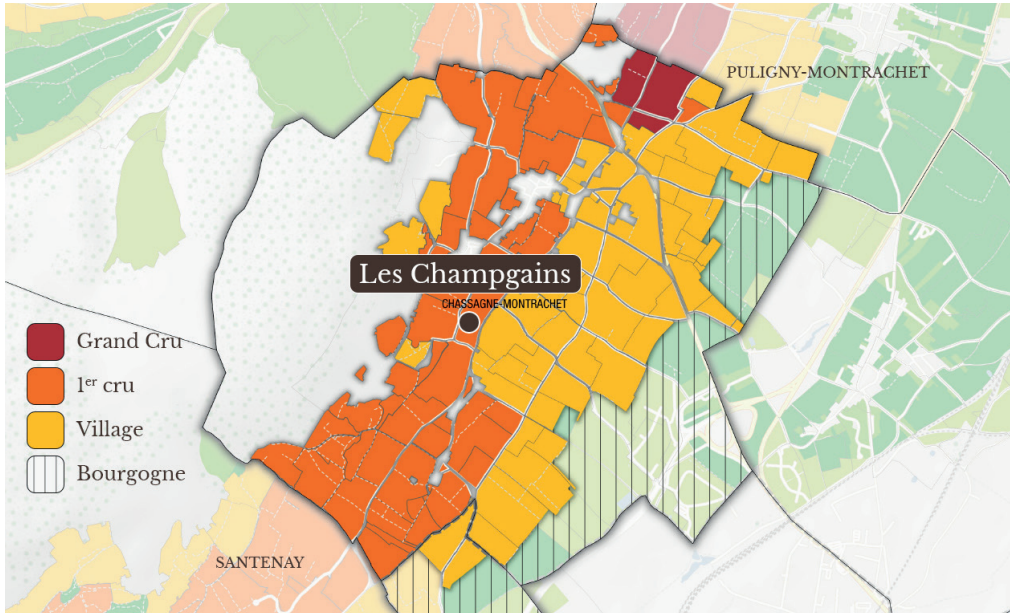


Chassagne-Montrachet
