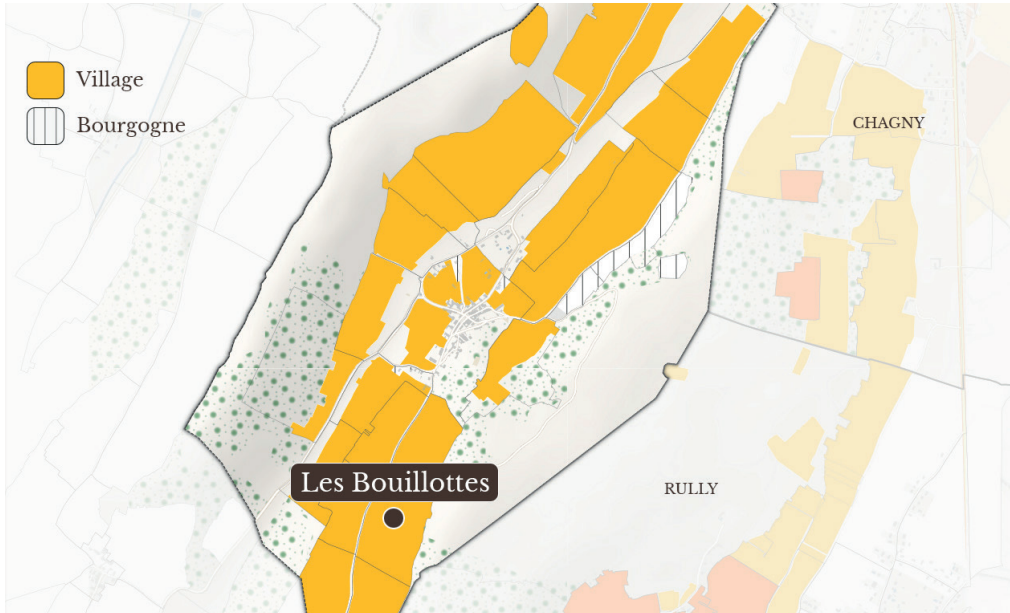


## Bouzeron

### PLOT

**Grape variety:** Aligoté

**Colour:** White

**Surface area:** 0.54 ha

**Exposure:** East

**Soil:** White marl with limestone dominating

**Vine age:** 45 years old



**A**dded to our estate in 2014, Les Bouillottes completes our range of Aligoté (“Les Grands Champs” in Chassagne-Montrachet). Created by the appellation decree of 17 February 1998, the Village appellation for wines made from the Aligoté grape variety in the Côte Chalonnaise region of Saône-et-Loire, Bouzeron is one of the five appellations of the Côte Chalonnaise, and the closest to Chassagne-Montrachet. Bouzeron, AOC Village, is exclusively cultivated on the upper slopes on land composed of white marl with a predominantly limestone base.

### TASTING

Ideal drinking window of 5 to 8 years – variable depending on transport and storage conditions.

Ageing potential of 10 years – variable depending on transport and storage conditions.
