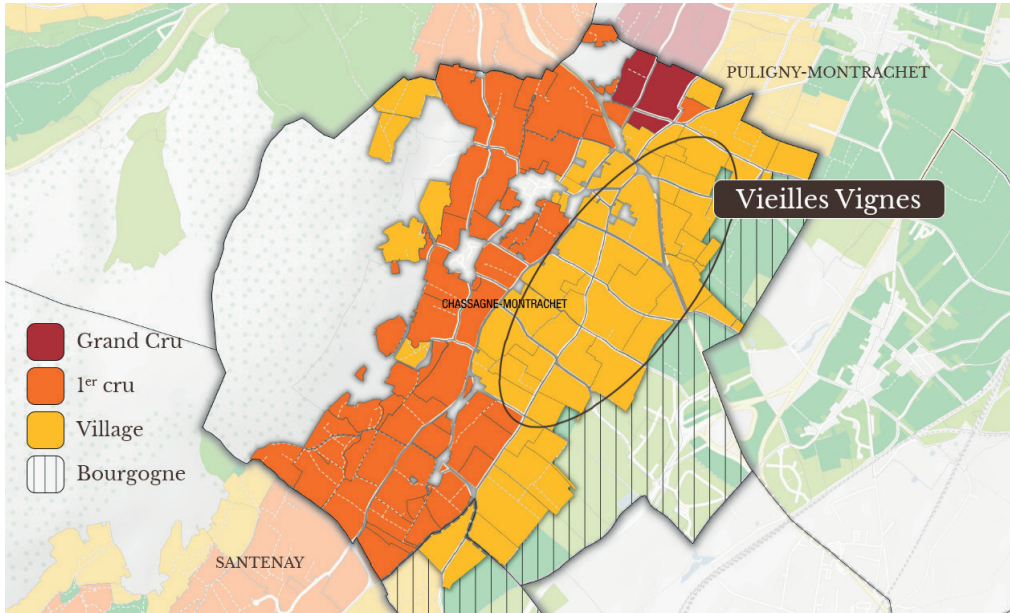


# Chassagne-Montrachet

### PLOT

**Grape variety:** Pinot noir

**Colour:** Red

**Surface area:** 2.30 ha

**Exposure:** East

**Soil:** Clay and limestone

**Vine age:** 45 years old



The iconic Chassagne red wine is produced from a dozen plots located on the lower slopes with a wide exposure from the north-east to the south-west: a balance of a very superior aromatic quality.
